Using Your Slime Kit Safely

Full safety information is at the back of this book. Please make sure an adult reads these instructions before using the kit.

Children should use this kit under the supervision of adults. The kit is not suitable for children under 3 years old.

Keep contents of kit away from eyes and mouth. In case of contact, wash with plenty of water.

Tips and Tricks Page

Uh oh! My slime isn't looking quite right. What can I do?!

We have loads of simple solutions to help you get back on track with your slime.

It's not mixing or it's not bright enough.

Make sure to add the color BEFORE you add activator water. This will help to make sure the color gets mixed in correctly. If you need it to be brighter, you can always add a little more.

I want a stretchier slime. How can I do that?

To ensure your slime is super stretchy you can try adding some clay from the kit after you have made your slime. Slime needs to be played with and absorb the heat from your hands to get really stretchy.

My slime is all wet and nasty. What's wrong?

Sometimes if you get the ratio of glue or activator water a little bit wrong then your slime can be a little bit wet. There are two simple things you can do to fix this:

- 1. The slime must be kneaded really well for at least 5 minutes. A good method for kneading is to squash, stretch and fold the slime and knead it between your thumb and fingers. As long as you have used the correct amounts of glue and activator as directed, you will notice that after 5 minutes of this kneading method, that the slime will begin to form and lose its stickiness.
- 2. If after kneading your slime really well, it is still wet and sticky, try adding 2 or 3 small drops (not squirts) of activator and repeat the kneading process.
- 3. Finally, you could try leaving the slime to dry for 2 to 4 hours. This is best if you have added too much water.

I left my slime for a day and now it's dried up. Can I fix it?

It's difficult to revive a dead slime. The best thing to do is start again and have loads more fun making new slime. Remember to keep your slime in the containers provided to make sure it lasts a long time.

I've mixed it but it doesn't look like fluffy slime. How come?

Fluffy slime, and in fact all slimes, need to be played with in your hands for at least 10 minutes to soften up and get stretchy. The warmth from your hands and the squashing and stretching motion gets all of the ingredients properly mixed and working together. The kit does include everything you need for amazing fluffy slime and if you follow our step by step instructions you will be making the perfect fluffy slime in no time! When you get more confident at making fluffy slime, why not experiment and add a little shaving foam or hand lotion to see how it makes your fluffy slime different? Have fun, get creative and enjoy!

Some important rules to remember when you are learning to make slime.

- 1. Always add colors and scents with the glue and stir before you add the activator to the mixture to ensure the liquids are distributed equally.
- 2. NEVER use too much activator at once. Only use very small quantities at a time and then stir for 30 seconds each time to ensure you don't make your slime too hard. Slime making requires patience and determination!
- 3. Have fun and experiment with your slime recipes! Bring out your inner scientist and enjoy the process!

Learn the art of Slime Swirling!

Ok, so you want to learn how to get the perfect little pile of swirled slime to make your fluffy slime look exactly like soft serve ice cream?

It takes practice but here are some handy tips to achieving the perfect slime swirl!

The key to making the perfect swirl is to play with your slime and get it really long and stretchy so fine lines form in the slime. A good technique for you to follow is:

- Hold your slime in both hands and stretch it out as far as it will go at arms length.
- Then fold it by bringing your hands back together.
- Stretch it out again and fold it.
- Keep repeating the process for about 1 minute.
- When you slime is super long and fine lines have formed in it, stick one end of the slime to a clean surface and slowly let the rest of the slime drop down into a swirled shape like a meringue.
- Get a friend to do a close up video of your swirl to see how it looks on film!
- Tip! For amazing stretch and super defined lines in the slime we always advise adding some clay to your slime!



What's in my Ice Cream Slime Kit?



All contents in this kit are Non-Edible! Do not eat or put any of the contents of this kit near or in your mouth!

Basic Fluffy Slime

To make the basic fluffy slime recipe you will need:













10 squirts of foam soap

A color ink of your choice

2 spoonfuls of activator

A mixing bowl

BEFORE YOU START: the inks could stain and slime is messy. Use a plastic sheet or non-porous tablecloth to protect your surface. Wear old clothes. If you get slime on your clothes, hand wash immediately in very warm water. This will help the glue to break down.

- Using the measuring cup, measure out 30ml of the glue. Pour the glue into a separate mixing bowl.
- Next add 10 squirts of the magic foaming soap to the glue and 3 or 4 squirts of your favorite coloring (**Top tip!** White coloring will give you the classic marshmallow fluffy slime look!). Give them all a good stir for about 30 seconds so the glue, the coloring and the foam soap are well combined.
- Finally, add 1 spoonful of activator water spread evenly around the bowl (try not to tip the activator all in one place in the bowl), using the measuring spoon in the kit. Stir for 30 seconds and then add in another 1 spoonful of activator, again spread evenly around the fluffy slime. Stir for another 30 seconds or so.
- When your slime is at this stage you can start to play with it in your hands. Play with the fluffy slime for 5 to 10 minutes to allow the warmth from your hands into the slime. A good method to get your slime super stretchy is to knead it by squashing it, stretching it and folding it repeatedly. This will soften your slime and make it super stretchy
- This is the basic fluffy slime recipe that you will need to master for all of your other fluffy slime recipes!

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Fluffy Butter Slime

To make a lovely fluffy butter slime recipe you will need:

Stirrer from your kit





- Once you have made a yellow basic fluffy slime, take a small handful of the clay from the bag (remember to re-seal the bag so your clay doesn't dry out!)
- Place the clay on top of your slime and begin to knead them together until the slime and clay are fully mixed. The warmth from your hands really helps the soft, fluffy, stretchy texture to develop. The more you play with it, the fluffier it will be! You will be left with a delicious, glossy looking creamy yellow butter slime!"
- EXPERIMENT! Try adding 1 level spoonful of dry snow powder to the butter slime and knead it in for an authentic vanilla ice cream texture!

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Vanilla Fluffy Slime

- Firstly, you will need to make a basic fluffy slime récipe.
- Next, add 3 to 5 squirts of the yellow coloring and 3 squirts of the vanilla scent before you add the activator.
- Mix everything together until you have a fluffy vanilla slime.
- Take the slime and knead it in your hands for about 5 minutes.
- You can make this slime even more fluffy and buttery by adding a small handful of clay and working it into the slime - it feels

EXPERIMENT! To make your vanilla fluffy slime look and smell even more like real ice cream, add in 1 level spoonful of dry snow powder and a small handful of clay and knead it all together. Experiment with different toppings like candy sprinkles and strawberry sauce (red coloring) and wow your friends and family with your fluffy ice cream slime! Which other topping combinations can you think of?





Strawberry Swirl Fluffy Slime

- Make a basic fluffy slime but add 4 squirts of the red coloring and 3 to 5 squirts of strawberry scent before you add the activator.
- Give it all a good stir for 30 seconds and then play with it in your hands until it becomes fluffy and stretchy.
- Next add a small handful of clay and knead everything together for a few minutes.
- Make a second batch of basic fluffy slime, but this time, add 1 squirt of red color and 2 squirts of the white coloring to make a lighter pink slime.
- Add a small handful of clay and knead it with the
- You should now have 2 pink fluffy slimes.
- Stretch them both out next to each other then swirl them together but don't knead them together as you want to keep the color swirl effect!

EXPERIMENT! Leave the 2 separate strawberry swirled slimes in a container overnight together to settle. See how the 2 pinks mix when they are left to settle - how does it look? You can also try adding different toppings and extra strawberry sauce (red coloring) on top of your slime!





Basic Fluffy Slime

Clay

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Chocolate Chip and Cherry Fluffy Slime



- Make the basic fluffy slime recipe but add 4 squirts of the brown coloring and 3 to 5 squirts of the chocolate scent before you add the activator.
- Give it all a really good stir for 30 seconds.
- Knead it in your hands until it becomes fluffy and stretchy.
- Next add a small handful of clay and knead everything together for a few minutes.
- Finish your chocolate chip slime with chocolate sprinkles and cherries on top.
- Marvel at your creation, then enjoy folding the chocolate chips and cherries into the slime and have fun playing! Can you make the perfect chocolate cherry slime swirl?!

Mint Chocolate Chip Fluffy Slime

- Make the basic fluffy slime recipe adding 2 squirts of the green coloring and 1 squirt of the white coloring before you add the activator.
- Give it all a good stir for 30 seconds.
- When the fluffy slime has formed, knead it hands until it becomes fluffy and stretchy.
- Next add a small handful of clay and knead everything together for a few minutes.
- Lastly, sprinkle on a small amount of the chocolate chips and fold them into the slime!

EXPERIMENT! Try switching up the recipe to a pistachio color ice cream by adding in 2 squirts of yellow coloring with the green at the beginning!



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Neapolitan Fluffy Slime

The Classic Neapolitan
Strawberry, Chocolate and Vanilla fluffy slime ice cream!
You will need:



- This is our favorite! Let's make the strawberry fluffy slime first by measuring out 30ml of glue into your measuring cup.
- Add 2 drops of red coloring and 2 drops of white coloring along with 3 to 5 squirts of strawberry scent.
- Next, add 10 squirts of foaming soap and give everything a really good stir until everything is combined.
- Add 1 level spoonful of activator and mix everything together until you have a fluffy pink slime which smells of yummy strawberry. Set the strawberry slime to one side while you make the others.
- For the vanilla fluffy slime, follow the same method, but use 2 squirts of yellow coloring and the 3 to 5 squirts of vanilla scent instead. Once this is done, set it aside separately from the Strawberry slime.
- Finally, make the chocolate fluffy slime. Follow the same method again, but use 2 squirts of brown coloring and 3 to 5 squirts of the chocolate scent.
- Have fun playing with the fluffy slimes but don't mix them all together just yet!
- If you want to add a small amount of clay to each for a fluffy buttery texture you can add this now to each slime.
- Ok, now the fun part! Lay all 3 slimes next to each other and create a delicious smelling swirl of Neapolitan fluffy slime!

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Bring out your inner scientist and create your own recipes and experiments with your slimes. Slime making is all about being creative, having fun and perfecting your slime making skills!

PER ITEM SAFETY AND FIRST AID MEASURES

Clay, Glue, Glitter, Colour Ink: This is NOT considered hazardous under the GHS classification. In case of inhalation, skin contact, eye contact, or swallowing, please follow the standard first aid measures outlined below.

STANDARD FIRST AID MEASURES

IF INHALED: Move person into fresh air. If unconscious, place in recovery position and seek medical advice. If symptoms persist, call a physician.
